

**ORDINANCE NO. 2009-008**

**AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A FOUR WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION  
OF McCLELLAND STREET and CEDAR STREET**

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the Town of Bluff City, Tennessee deem it necessary to create a four way stop at the intersection of McClelland Street and Cedar Street to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens.

**BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND  
ALDERMEN OF THE TOWN OF BLUFF CITY, TENNESSEE:**

1. That a four way stop shall be created at the intersection of McClelland Street and Cedar Street.
2. That the appropriate signage shall be erected upon this ordinance becoming law.
3. The penalty for violation of this ordinance shall be the same as found in the Bluff City Municipal Code Section 3-201 which is \$15.00.
4. This ordinance shall become effective from and after its final passage the public welfare requiring it.
