**Resolution No. 2019-001**

**A Resolution Approving Amendment of the City-County Sewer Agreement  
Project List for Bristol, Tennessee**

WHEREAS, *A Policy for Sanitary Sewer Extensions in Sullivan County, April 1996*, commonly known as the City-County Sewer Agreement, was approved by the cities of Bluff City, Kingsport, and Bristol, and Sullivan County; and

WHEREAS, Exhibit A of the City-County Sewer Agreement established the list of projects to be undertaken by the County and each of the respective cities; and

WHEREAS, by resolution dated March 8, 2006, the City of Bristol approved a modification of Exhibit A to delete certain projects and add other projects in the City of Bristol's project list; and

WHEREAS, this modification of Exhibit A was also approved by the Cities of Bluff City and Kingsport, and by Sullivan County; and

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2019 at its regular meeting, the Sullivan County Board of Commissioners approved a resolution modifying the Bristol Projects List on Exhibit A by removing Paperville Knob, Beaver Creek Road, and Evans Creek, Phase 1, from the Project List, and replacing them with a three-phase Weaver Pike project; and

WHEREAS, Phase 1 of the Weaver Pike Project would include sewer lines that extend from Sullivan East High School to Sullivan East Middle School to the White Top Sewer Trunk Line along Broyles Lane and Phase 2 would extend from Broyles Lane to former Weaver Elementary and Phase 3 would extend from former Weaver Elementary to Old Jonesboro Road; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bluff City agrees that Exhibit A should be modified in this way.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Bluff City, Tennessee, that Exhibit A of the City-County Sewer Agreement is hereby amended with the deletion of the Paperville Knob, Beaver Creek Road, and Evans Creek, Phase 2 projects, and the insertion of the following projects: Weaver Pike Phase 1, Weaver Pike Phase 2, and Weaver Pike Phase 3.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the completion of the three phases of the Weaver Pike Project will fulfill the commitment of Sullivan County to the City of Bristol for projects under the City-County Sewer Agreement.
