Public Hearing opened at 9:05 a.m. There were no comments. Public Hearing closed at 9:06 a.m. Motion to approve Ordinance 2018-004 on Second Reading was made by Alderman Bowling. Second by Vice Mayor Harrington. All in favor. Motion carried.

Public Hearing on Ordinance 2018-005


City Attorney Paul Frye read the ordinance which amends the Bluff City Municipal Code Section 17-111(1) regarding Garbage Collection Fees within the Town of Bluff City reflecting a 50 cent monthly increase. Public Hearing opened at 9:07 p.m. Alderman Bowling stated where some people have part of their property in the City and part in the County, do they contact you about garbage disposal or do you contact them whether they want it or not. City Attorney Paul Frye stated that in that instance of a split parcel and the entire parcel is not within the town limits they have the option of taking it or not taking it. City Recorder / CMFO Sharon Greene informed him that they have to contact the city to request garbage pickup. 
Citizen Comments – Second Section – None
